

Wisbech Town Cricket Club Junior Section Code of Conduct **FOR JUNIOR MEMBERS AND PLAYERS**



In order for Wisbech Town Cricket Club to run a successful youth section we expect every junior member at the Club to follow and abide by the Code of Conduct for the following reasons:-

- We take pride in ourselves and our Club
- We care for and respect each other at the Club
- We want every junior member to achieve their best
- We all have the right to learn and develop

So this can happen, every member of the junior section must show respect:-

- RESPECT for your Coaches and Match Officials
- RESPECT for yourself
- RESPECT for other members
- RESPECT for the Club facilities and equipment
- RESPECT for learning

All junior players at Wisbech Town Cricket Club will:-

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person within the context of Cricket
- Treat everyone equally and not discriminate on the grounds of age, gender, disability, race, ethnic origin, nationality, colour, parental or marital status, religious belief, class or social background, sexual preference or political belief
- Report to the Lead Coach immediately if any form of discrimination is witnessed
- Display high standards of behaviour
- Undertake the positive aspects of cricket eg fair play
- Learn the Laws and Rules and play within them, respecting the decisions of match officials
- Not participate in unfair play, rule violations or arguing with match officials
- Not smoke, drink or use banned substances whilst actively taking part at the Club
- Not attempt to purchase alcohol from the bar or ask adult members to purchase it for you
- Not use any form of offensive or abusive language under any circumstances
- Listen to and follow all instructions given by the Coaches particularly in regards to safety especially in a net situation
- Never under any circumstances bully any other member of the youth section whether it be Emotional, Physical, Sexual or Verbal
- Inform the Lead Coach immediately if you are aware of any form of bullying

DISCIPLINARY ACTION WILL BE TAKEN AND A BAN MAY BE
IMPOSED
