

Wisbech Town Cricket Club Junior Section Code of Conduct FOR PARENTS/CARERS AND SPECTATORS



In order for Wisbech Town Cricket Club to run a successful youth section we expect every Parent/Carer of youth members at the Club to follow and abide by the Code of Conduct for the following reasons:-

- We take pride in ourselves and our Club
- We care for and respect each other at the Club
- We want every junior member to achieve their best
- We all have the right to learn and develop

So this can happen, Parent/Carer of youth members at the Club must show respect:-

- RESPECT for the Coaches and Match Officials
- RESPECT for all other members including the opposition side
- RESPECT for the Club facilities and equipment

All Parent/Carers of junior players at Wisbech Town Cricket Club will:-

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person within the context of Cricket
- Treat everyone equally and not discriminate on the grounds of age, gender, disability, race, ethnic origin, nationality, colour, parental or marital status, religious belief, class or social background, sexual preference or political belief
- Report to the Lead Coach immediately if any form of discrimination is witnessed
- Behave in an appropriate manner
- Undertake the positive aspects of cricket eg fair play
- Respect the decisions of Match Officials
- Not participate or encourage unfair play, rule violations or arguing with match officials
- Not purchase alcohol for any junior members
- Not use any form of offensive or abusive language under any circumstances
- Never under any circumstances bully any member of the youth section whether it be Emotional, Physical, Sexual or Verbal
- Inform the Lead Coach immediately if you are aware of any form of bullying
